AMENDMENTS AGREED TO

CLAUSE 1

1. On page 4, line 5, to insert the following definition—

“accredited training provider” means a person, organisation or institution providing training, guidance or education within the tourism industry and in compliance with the criteria and standards set out by The Authority;”.
2. On page 4, line 11, after the word “tourists” to add “, including car hire;”.
3. On page 4, line 18, after the word “Fund” to add the words “established in terms of section 14 of this Act;”.
4. On page 5, line 8, to delete the words “training provider means any person, organisation or institution providing training, guidance or education within the tourism industry in the province; and”.

CLAUSE 4

1. On page 5, lines 33 and 34, to omit the words “improve standards and”.
2. On page 5, line 35, to delete the word “and”.
3. On page 5, line 37, after the words “as such”, to add “; and”.
4. On page 5, line 38, to add the following paragraph—

“(11) register tourist guides in accordance with the Tourism Act, 1993 (Act No. 72 of 1993)”.

CLAUSE 7

1. On page 6, lines 9 and 10, to delete the words “ for the unexpired portion of the period of office concerned”.

CLAUSE 17

1. On page 9, line 6, after the word “authority” to delete the words “for the Authority”.
2. On page 9, line 6, after the word “must” to delete the words “promptly and”.
3. On page 9, line 6, to omit the words “relevant treasury” and to substitute with the word “Treasury”.
4. On page 9, line 7, after the word “submit” to omit the word “relevant”.
5. On page 9, line 10, after the word “in” to omit the words “a significant”.
6. On page 9, line 12, after the word “of” to omit the words “a significant”.
7. On page 9, line 13, after the word “of” to omit the words “a significant”.
8. On page 9, line 14, after the word “of” to omit the words “a significant”.

9. On page 9, line 15, before the word “change” to omit the words “a significant”.
10. On page 9, line 15, after the words “interest in” to omit the words “a significant”.
11. On page 9, lines 18 and 19, to delete the words “or within a longer period as may be agreed to between itself and the MEC”.

CLAUSE 22

1. On page 10, line 39, to omit the word “A” and to substitute with the word “Such”.
2. On page 10, line 39, after the word “paid” to omit the word “such”.

CLAUSE 27

1. On page 11, line 39, to delete paragraph “(d)” as a whole and to substitute with—

“(d) a criminal convicted without an option of a fine; and”.

CLAUSE 30

1. On page 12, lines 17 and 18, to omit the words “registered entities and persons active in tourism industry”.
2. On page 12, line 17, after the word “of” to add the words “entities registered in terms of section 32”.
3. On page 12, line 20, to omit the word “Province” and to substitute with the word “Department”.

CLAUSE 31

1. On page 12, line 26, after the first word “tourist” to omit the word “amenity”.
2. On page 12, line 32, to delete paragraph (a) as a whole.

CLAUSE 32

1. On page 12, line 41, after the word “conference” to insert the words “and exhibition”.

CLAUSE 35

1. On page 13, line 16, to delete the word “certification” and to substitute with the word “certificate”.

CLAUSE 37

1. On page 13, line 24, to omit “twelve (12)” and to substitute with “twenty-four (24)”.

CLAUSE 38

1. On page 13, line 34, to omit the word “may” and to substitute with the word “must”.

CLAUSE 39

1. On page 13, line 42, to omit the words “tour guide,”.
2. On page 13, line 46, after the words “a registered” to omit the words “tour guide,”.

CLAUSE 42

1. On page 14, line 35, to omit the word “may” and to substitute with the word “must”.

GENERAL

1. Throughout the Bill, the words “tour guide” be substituted with the words “tourist guide”.
2. Throughout the Bill, the words “training provider” be substituted with the words “accredited training provider”.
